What is CIDP?

CIDP (chronic inflammatory demyelinating polyneuropathy) is a rare autoimmune condition that affects the nerves in the peripheral nervous system.

This condition causes progressive muscle weakness and sensory impairment in the arms and legs. Often those living with CIDP have difficulty lifting objects, experience loss of balance, trouble walking, neuropathic pain, and fatigue.
